VAL AND SKY'S STORY

Val and Sky had extremely challenging childhoods, growing up with absent parents. After some time in a group home, their grandparents were awarded custody, but during the pandemic, their grandfather passed away from COVID and did not have a will in place to keep the family together.

As a result, their grandmother lost their home and was unable to qualify for apartments due to her limited income. They became homeless - staying in their grandmother's vehicle until they were connected to our shelter program in July 2022. Our team helped them quickly transition to a permanent home via public housing in August 2022. Their family completed a year of our Stabilization program, learning budgeting and saving skills, and have continued to remain stably housed.

Val enlisted with the Navy after graduating high school in 2023, completed basic training later that year, and is now a Sailor. Sky is also doing well - she graduated high school this year and has been accepted to Eastern Florida State College to begin her college education. We are so proud of this family and can't wait to see what the girls go on to accomplish!


2023 FINANCIAL OVERVIEW
